TASTING NOTES

Chardonnay is the world's most famous white-wine grape and also one of the most widely planted. Introduced to Italy in the early 19th Century, Chardonnay thrives in the cool climate of the "Venezie" territory - a vast area encompassing the regions of Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Trentino-Alto Adige, and Veneto. A crisp and inviting rendition of this international varietal, Silterra Chardonnay showcases bright aromas of apples, vibrant acidity and a clean finish. This is a refreshing and crisp Chardonnay, making it the ideal choice for salmon marinated in dill, couscous with oriental flavors or artichokes.

ABOUT THE WINERY

The Silterra line is produced by Tenuta Sant'Anna, the home base and flagship property of Le Tenute di Genagricola. The grapes for the white wines are sourced from winery-owned vineyards in the Lison Pramaggiore area, an appellation with a long tradition of winemaking. The grapes for the red wines are sourced from Lazio, from the Solonio estate which is also part of the Genagricola ownership. Silterra offers a variety of excellent value wines with a brand new packaging. A Chardonnay and a Cabernet Sauvignon have recently been added to complete the line.
