<b>VINIFICATION &amp; AGING</b>	After harvesting and crushing the grapes, the must obtained is left to cold-soak with the grape-skins, without stalks and seeds at temperatures between 25-28°C for seven to eight days and pumped over frequently. After the first alcoholic fermentation, the malolactic fermentation takes place in steel vats and then the wine is transferred to 300-liter barrels to rest for two to three months.

<b>NOTES</b>	The new 'Poderi' line refers to the individual <i>plots</i> from which the grapes are sourced and are intended to be the best selection from each of the varietals.

#### TASTING NOTES

Merlot has been cultivated in north-eastern Italy (Veneto in particular) since the 19th century and has since become fully acclimatized to the area and produces smooth, full-bodied wines with distinct aromas of red-berried fruit complemented by subtle notes of spice. It is the perfect accompaniment for lasagne, gnocchi with rich meat sauces, beef stew with polenta or a great BBQ!
